

Eos: A Timeline

Year	Members	Volume
1920	45	Vol. I, no. 1 of <i>Transactions</i> . Usually an annual volume.
1945	2,230	Vol. 26—The beginning of the publication of peer-reviewed contributed scientific articles in addition to meetings proceedings and other materials. Publishes six times per year.
1959	5,200	Vol. 40—Scientific articles begin to shift to <i>JGR</i> and later <i>Reviews of Geophysics</i> , <i>Water Resources Research</i> , and other new AGU journals. <i>Transactions</i> reverts to quarterly publication.
1969	9,905	Vol. 50— <i>Transactions</i> adds <i>Eos</i> to its name and is published as a monthly magazine.
1979	12,595	Vol. 60— <i>Eos, Transactions</i> is published for the first time as a weekly tabloid newspaper.
2006	48,001	Vol. 87—The tabloid <i>Eos</i> has been available electronically as well as in print for 3 years and is used in that form by nearly 6,000 members. Online electronic moderated discussions introduced in 2006.
